Trauma Informed Care: Building a Safe Place

This training looks at ways we can help children recover and become more resilient. Safety is important for all children but it is particularly crucial for children who have experienced trauma. For these youth the world has become a harsh and unpredictable place. To heal they need to feel safe and to believe there are adults in their lives who can offer security and safety. We will define the components of safety and share ideas of how we can help children know they are in a safe place with caregivers, beyond just the physical aspects.
